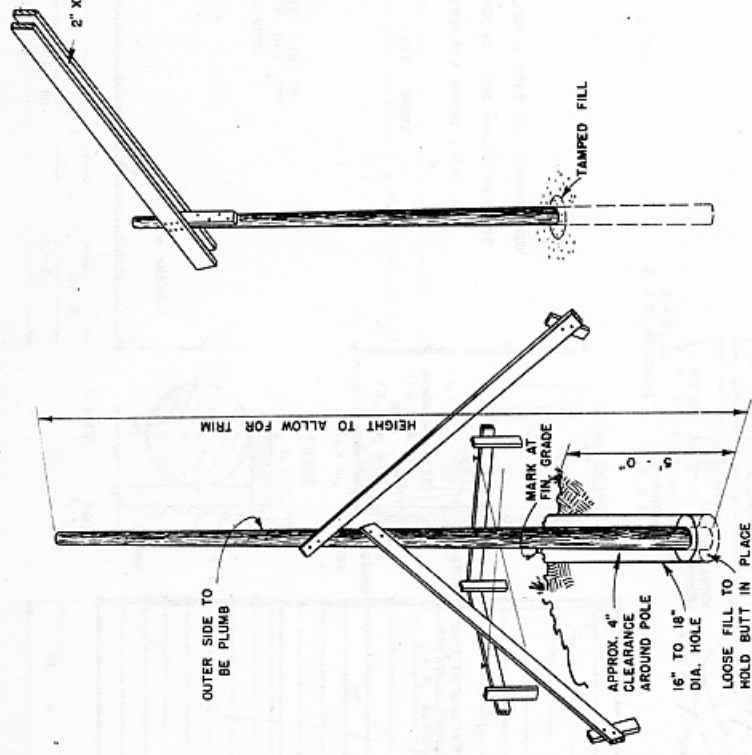
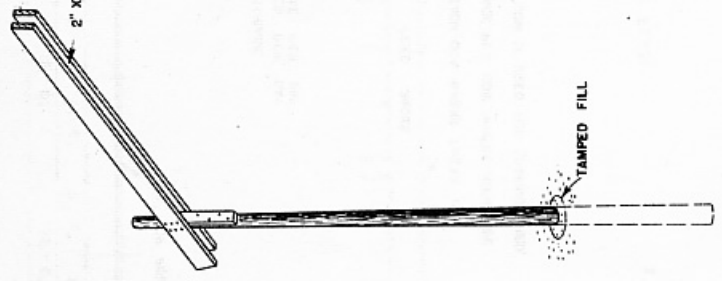

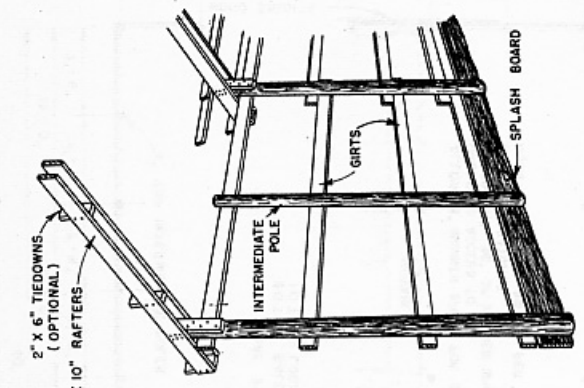
ERECTION OF BALANCE OF POLES & RAFTERS

NOTE

THIS BUILDING IS DESIGNED FOR AREAS OF THE SOUTHERN UNITED STATES WHERE THE SNOW LOAD DOES NOT EXCEED 10" PER SQ. FT. & WIND LOAD NOT EXCEED 88 MI. PER HOUR. IN A FEW AREAS, SUCH AS NORTHERN VIRGINIA & WESTERN KENTUCKY WHERE SNOW LOADS EXCEED 10" PER SQ. FT., 2" X 12" RAFTERS SHOULD BE USED INSTEAD OF THE 2" X 10" RAFTERS SHOWN & PURLINS SHOULD BE SPACED 16" O.C. INCREASE NUMBER OF 30d NAILS IN RAFTER TO POLE CONNECTIONS 40%. IT SHOULD NOT BE USED IN OTHER AREAS WITHOUT REDESIGNING FRAMING TO MEET LOCAL CONDITIONS.
