

CASNR Distinguished Alumnus Award

The CASNR Distinguished Alumnus Award is presented annually to a graduate (at least 10 years) of the CASNR, or its predecessor, the College of Agriculture, for outstanding achievement in the academic or corporate community and/or noteworthy public service, which have brought distinction to the graduate and The University of Tennessee.

The recipient will be selected by a committee composed of the CASNR faculty, students and alumni.

The award recipient is invited to the CASNR Scholarship and Awards Banquet and/or the College's Spring Graduation Ceremony.

The nominations, by alumni, faculty or department heads, consist of the nomination form (see back) and a letter (**maximum of 3 pages**) that includes the following information:

- Name of the nominee
- A statement of significant accomplishments in the academic, corporate and/or community/public service arenas.
- Additional comments regarding the nominee and how s/he distinguished him/herself and/or The University of Tennessee.
- An additional five letters of support may be submitted on behalf of the nominee.

A CV or resume may be attached, if available.

The nominator must include his/her full address, work and home telephone numbers and e-mail address. Nominations should be post-marked no later than **the third Friday of February** and sent to:
